SECTION A – CUT SPECIMENS

1. Hyacinth, any colour, 1 spike
2. Iris, dwarf, 1 stalk
3. Lily of the valley, 5 stems
4. Narcissus, (Daffodil), trumpet, 1 stem
5. Narcissus, large cup, 1 stem
6. Narcissus, small cup, 1 stem
7. Narcissus, any other variety, 1 stem
8. Tulip, 1 stem
9. Any flowering bulb, corm or rhizome, 1 stem
10. Violas, (Pansies, Johnny jump-ups), 5 blooms
11. Collection of rockery flowers and/or small flowering bulbs, 3 or more kinds, must be named
12. Helleborus (e.g. Christmas Rose), 1 stem
13. Flowering Branch, natural or forced, not to exceed 76 cm
14. Branch, foliage only, natural or forced, not to exceed 76 cm
15. Any other flowering perennial, 1 stem

SECTION B – NOVICE CORNER - PEOPLE'S CHOICE

This section is for novices only. In this category, a novice is anyone who has not yet won a first-place ribbon in an EYGC flower show. Voting will take place between 7:15 and 7:30. All those who are in attendance at the meeting will be eligible to vote.

Note: winners will be ribboned, but this category does not count towards points for the Anna Leggatt Award or George Henry Trophy.

1. Any cut specimen

SECTION C – HOUSE PLANTS

1. African violet, 1 crown, 1 pot
2. Cactus or succulent, 1 pot
3. House plant, foliage, 1 pot
4. Orchid, 1 pot
5. Any other house plant, flowering, 1 pot

SECTION D – DESIGN CATEGORIES

2012 Design Theme: Notable Events and Anniversaries

April Show Theme: 2012 - The Year of the Dragon

1. White Knight – A design incorporating white flowers
 - a) Experienced exhibitors
 - b) Novice exhibitors (A person who has not yet won a first-place ribbon in a design category at an EYGC flower show.)
2. Golden Dragon – An oriental design
3. Paper Bag Princess – A design using a paper bag
4. Free Spirit – An interpretative design
5. Puff – A miniature design (maximum dimensions 12.7 cm)

SECTION E – PRESERVES

Full container, made within the previous 12 months and vacuum-sealed. No more than two entries per class per household. Ingredients must be listed.

1. Chili Sauce or Salsa, 1 jar
2. Jam, 1 jar
3. Jelly, 1 jar (clear)
4. Marmalade, 1 jar
5. Pickles, 1 jar
6. Vinegar, flavoured, 1 jar
7. Any other kind of preserves, 1 jar
