1. Aquilegia (Columbine), 1 stem
2. Aruncus, (Goatsbeard), 1 stem, not to exceed 1 metre
3. Clematis, with leaves, 1 stem
4. Hosta, one cultivar, 3 leaves
5. Hosta, 3 cultivars, one leaf each cultivar
6. Hosta, small or miniature, 1 leaf
7. Dianthus (Pinks), 3 stems
8. Hemerocallis (Daylily), 1 stalk
9. Iris, bearded, 1 stalk
10. Iris, bearded, 2 stalks
11. Iris, Siberian, 1 stalk
12. Iris, Siberian, 3 stalks
13. Iris, any other variety
14. Lilium (Lily), 1 stalk
15. Peony, single, 1 bloom
16. Peony, double, 1 bloom
17. Peony, semi-double, 1 bloom
18. Peony, any other kind, 1 bloom
19. Peony, collection, at least 3 varieties, 3-6 blooms
20. Rose, hybrid tea, 1 bloom
21. Rose, grown for fragrance, 1 bloom
22. Rose, floribunda, 1 stem
23. Rose, grandiflora, 1 stem
24. Rose, polyanthus, 1 spray
25. Rose, climber or rambler, 1 stem
26. Rose, shrub, 1 stem
27. Rose, any kind not listed, 1 stem
28. Rose, floating in bowl with foliage
29. Rose, full blown, 1 bloom
30. Rose, miniature, 1 bloom or spray
31. Rose, collection 5 or more cultivars
32. Violas (Pansies) 5 stems with leaves
33. Any other perennial or biennial, 1 stem
34. Any other perennial or biennial, 3 stems
35. Any other flowering bulb, corm or tuber, 1 stem, spike or spray
36. Collection of flowers, 1 kind only
37. Collection of flowers, 3 or more kinds
38. Flowering tree/shrub, 1 branch, not to exceed 1 metre

SECTION B – PLANTS

1. African violet, 1 crown, 1 pot
2. Cactus or succulent, 1 pot
3. House plant, flowering, 1 pot
4. House plant, foliage, 1 pot

SECTION C – FRUITS & VEGETABLES

1. Rhubarb, 3 stalks, on a plate (trim stalks to a 2.5 cm fan)
2. Herbs, 3 or more varieties, displayed in water, must be named
3. Any other fruit or vegetable, 1 to 3

4. The Battle of Lake Erie – A design with visible use of water
